Dear Members of UUSD:

On behalf of the Board of Trustees, I invite you to attend the UUSD Annual Congregational Meeting on Sunday, June 8, 2025 at 11:15 a.m. The meeting will be held in person, in UUSD's sanctuary. All members are urged to attend. We need a minimum of 80 members at the meeting to have a quorum and conduct business. That business will include election of three Board members and four Leadership Development Committee members. We will also vote on a new budget for the 2025-2026 fiscal year, revised Resolution of Conscience, a minor change to the bylaws, and the 2024 annual meeting minutes.

Anyone who has been a member of UUSD for at least 30 days before the date of the Annual Meeting is eligible to vote. Absentee ballots will be available for any members unable to attend the Annual Meeting. Please note that absentee ballots must be received at UUSD, ATTN: Beth Law, not later than Sunday, June 8, 2025 at 11:00 AM in order to be counted.

An in-person informational meeting will be held at UUSD on Sunday, June 1, following the Sunday service. The meeting will begin about 11:15 a.m. in the sanctuary and will include review of the proposed fiscal year 2026 budget and the motions that will be voted on at the meeting. Full information on the candidates for office and ballot initiatives is available on the UUSD website in the Members section, on the 2025 Annual Meeting page. Reports from the minister, President of the Board of Trustees, committee chairs, and others will also be posted as they become available. Please take the time to read the reports, which provide a wonderful overview of all that has been accomplished by UUSD's members, friends, and staff. They are always an inspiring read!
